

Emmanuel Harvest thanksgiving: On **Sunday 15 September** there will be a Harvest All Age service around tables at 10.00am. This will be followed by a yummy Harvest Lunch around noon with apple themed desserts. Tickets are £5 for adults & £3 for children. Tickets are available from Sue M.

Each year we invite you to bring items for **Swindon Food Collective**, which they distribute to those in need, (due to low wages, family crisis, delayed payments, redundancy, bereavement, sickness, and the cost-of-living crisis). Food items they are currently in need of include: 1ltr bottles of squash, long life milk, long life juice, small jars of coffee, 500gms and 1 kgs Sugar, Tinned fruit, Tinned plum tomatoes, Tinned puddings (rice pudding, custard, semolina), angel delight, jellies. They also collect toiletries and household products. Their main needs currently are toothpaste, toothbrushes, shower gel and 2-in-1 shampoo.



Orchard Apples: Each year our orchard apples are available for use by church members, family and friends. Please collect up windfalls and pick any fruit from the trees you would like, rather than let it go to waste.
